God said He would send these to drive out some of the wicked people from the land (Deuteronomy 7:20).






# Joshua fought with Amalek


Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim. And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand. So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill. ... And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword. (Exodus 17:8-10, 13)



And they [the twelve spies sent by Moses including Joshua] came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff. (Numbers 13:23)



And Moses spake unto the LORD, saying, Let the LORD... set a man over the congregation, which ... which may lead them out, and which may bring them in; that the congregation of the LORD be not as sheep which have no shepherd. And the LORD said unto Moses, Take thee Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay thine hand upon him; and set him before Eleazar the priest, and before all the congregation; and give him a charge in their sight. (Numbers 27:15-19)



[Rahab said] I pray you, swear unto me by the LORD, since I have shewed you kindness, that ye will also shew kindness unto my father's house, and give me a true token: And that ye will save alive my father, and my mother, and my brethren, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death. And the men answered her ... we will deal kindly and truly with thee. (Joshua 2:12-14)
