


Colouring book with pictures to copy

One of the most special things about David is that the Lord Jesus is often called the Son of David. This is because God promised to David that the Saviour would be born into his family line, and Jesus would be the King of kings to sit on David's throne for ever. Also, David was a type of Jesus—that means that David's life, in some measure, was like Jesus' life, and his poetry in the Psalms tells us about Jesus.

In this book, you will find pictures to colour which are about David and his poems. If a drawing interests you, perhaps you would like to read the story from the Bible? You can ask for help to find the right place.







want to colour.






David delivered the lamb out of the lion's mouth


